4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, the Constitution of Alabama
6	of 2022, provides for the salary, fees, and other
7	compensation received by a district attorney during his
8	or her term.
9	This bill would propose an amendment to the
10	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to provide that the
11	compensation received by a district attorney may not be
12	diminished during his or her term.

19	Proposing an amendment to Section 160 of the
20	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to provide that the
21	compensation received by a district attorney may not be
22	diminished during his or her term of office.
23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
25	of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:
26	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
27	Section 160 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is
28	amended to read as follows:

30 (a) A district attorney for each judicial circuit shall 31 be elected by the qualified electors of those counties in such 32 the circuit. Such The district attorney shall be licensed to practice law in this state and shall, at the time of his or 33 her election and during his or her continuance in office, 34 35 shall reside in his or her circuit. His The term of office 36 shall be for six years. and he He or she shall receive such compensation as provided by law; provided, the compensation 37 shall not be diminished during his or her official term. 38 39 Vacancies in the office of district attorney and in his or her

(b) Clerks of the circuit courts shall be elected by 41 42 the qualified electors in each county for a term of six years. 43 If the office of register in chancery continues to be provided by law then the clerk of the circuit court may also fill such 44 45 the office in a manner prescribed by law. Vacancies in the 46 office of clerk of the circuit court shall be filled by the judge or judges of the circuit court who have jurisdiction 47 48 over the county in which the office of clerk of the circuit 49 court is located.

staff shall be filled as provided by law.

(c) <u>Persons Individuals</u> elected to the position of constable to assist the courts of the state as provided by law shall be subject to the same restrictions, rights, and limitations as are specified in <u>section</u> 280 of the Constitution of <u>1901</u> <u>Alabama of 2022</u>, and no law shall prohibit the receipt of fees for the performance of official duties of <u>said</u> the position while holding any other elected or



57 appointed office.

(d) The revenue from fines, forfeitures, and court
costs produced in district courts from the exercise of
jurisdiction under municipal ordinances shall be apportioned
between the municipality and the state as shall be provided by
law.

63 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the 64 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional 65 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: 66 67 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest 68 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise 69 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize 70 71 language; and translate effective dates.

END OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

73 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 74 shall be held at the statewide primary election on May 26, 75 2026, in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 76 Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this 77 state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot 78 number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the 79 election ballot and shall set forth the following description 80 of the substance or subject matter of the proposed 81 constitutional amendment:

82 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama 83 of 2022, to provide that the compensation of a district 84 attorney may not be diminished during his or her term of

85 office.

86 Proposed by Act ____."

87 This description shall be followed by the following 88 language: 89 "Yes() No()."

90 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as 91 a part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved 92 by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
