A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to Elmore County; to levy an annual motor vehicle registration fee on each motor vehicle registered in Elmore County; and to provide for the distribution of the proceeds of the fee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall apply only to Elmore County.

Section 2. (a) For purposes of this section, the following terms have the following meanings:

(1) MOTOR VEHICLE. As defined by Section 40-12-240, Code of Alabama 1975.

(2) TRAILER. As defined by Section 40-12-240, Code of Alabama 1975.

(b) (1) The Revenue Commissioner of Elmore County shall charge and collect a twenty-five dollar (\$25) fee on each motor vehicle registration, transfer, or renewal.

(2) The fee established by this subsection shall not apply to trailers.

(c) The fee provided in subsection (b) shall be in addition to all other fees, taxes, and other charges provided by law.

29 (d) (1) On January 1 of each year, the amount of each
30 fee set in subsection (b) shall increase by one dollar (\$1).

31 (2) The Revenue Commissioner shall certify any
32 adjustment made pursuant to this subsection and shall publish
33 notice of the fee amounts and adjustments.

34 (e) The Revenue Commissioner shall collect the fees in
35 the same manner and at the same time as other motor vehicle
36 registration fees.

37 (f) (1) All proceeds from the collection of the fees
38 shall be deposited into the Enhance Elmore Fund.

39 (2) The county commission shall appropriate the
40 proceeds of these fees as follows:

41 a. Ninety-five percent for infrastructure.

42 b. Five percent for economic development.

43 Section 3. This act shall become effective on January
44 1, 2026.
