1 Enrolled, An Act,

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- Relating to Elmore County; to levy a county rental tax
- 4 and provide for the calculation of the rate; and to provide
- 5 for the distribution of the proceeds collected from the tax.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 7 Section 1. This act shall only apply to Elmore County.
- 8 Section 2. (a) In addition to all other taxes,
- 9 beginning September 1, 2025, there is levied a privilege tax,
- 10 to be called a rental tax, on each person leasing or renting
- 11 tangible personal property as provided by this section.
- 12 (b) The Revenue Commissioner of Elmore County shall
- 13 calculate the rates for the tax levied by this section using
- 14 the formulas as provided in subsection (c) rounded to the
- 15 nearest one tenth of a percent and shall publish notice of the
- 16 rates by August 1, 2025.
- 17 (c) (1) a. The rate for each incorporated area of the
- 18 county, including any police jurisdictions, shall be equal to
- 19 the difference of the following:
- 1. Nine and one-half percent;
- 21 LESS
- 22 2. The lesser of the following:
- (i) The general state rental tax rate levied pursuant
- 24 to Section 40-12-222(a)(1), Code of Alabama 1975; or
- 25 (ii) Four percent;

- 3. The applicable general rental or lease tax rate
- levied on the rental of tangible personal property by a

- 40 2. The lesser of the following:

- (d) Upon any change in the rates referenced in
- 45 subsection (c) that are used to calculate the county rental
- 46 tax rate, the revenue commissioner shall recalculate the

- (e) The county commission shall certify by resolution
- 50 the county rental tax rates levied by this section, including
- any recalculations provided by subsection (d).
- 52 (f) (1) Except as provided in subdivision (2), the tax
- 53 levied by this section shall parallel the tax imposed by
- 54 Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 40, Code of Alabama 1975.

- (2) Notwithstanding subdivision (1), the rental or
 lease of a motor vehicle that is required to be registered
 pursuant to Article 5 of Chapter 12 of Title 40 is exempt from
 this act.
- 61 (g) The county commission shall provide for the 62 collection and administration of this tax by resolution.
- (h) (1) The proceeds of this tax shall be deposited into the Enhance Elmore Fund.
- 65 (2) The county commission shall appropriate the 66 proceeds of this tax as follows:
- a. Ninety percent for infrastructure.
- b. Ten percent for economic development.
- Section 3. This act shall become effective on June 1,
