13	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
14	of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:
15	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
16	Part 1. The Judge of Probate of Morgan County shall be
17	an attorney licensed in this state effective for the term of
18	office of the judge of probate beginning after the
19	ratification of this amendment.
20	Part 2. The Judge of Probate of Morgan County may
21	exercise equity jurisdiction concurrent with that of the
22	circuit court in cases originally filed in the Probate Court
23	of Morgan County if the judge of probate is licensed to
24	practice law in the State of Alabama. In any case subject to
25	this amendment, the judge of probate shall possess the power
26	and authority of a circuit court judge trying the case and the
27	case shall be treated in all respects in the same manner as a

- 29 Procedure shall apply in the cases except as otherwise
- 30 specifically provided by law. This amendment is
- 31 self-executing, but the Legislature may enact additional laws
- 32 to implement this amendment if needed.
- 33 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
- 34 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
- 35 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
- 36 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:
- 37 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation
- 38 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest
- 39 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise
- 40 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize
- 41 language; and translate effective dates.
- 42 END PROPOSED AMENDMENT
- Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
- shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285
- 45 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws
- of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign
- 47 a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on
- 48 the election ballot and shall set forth the following
- description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed

- "Relating to Morgan County, proposing an amendment to
- 52 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to require the judge of
- 53 probate to be an attorney licensed in this state and to
- authorize the judge of probate to exercise equity jurisdiction
