3	To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama
4	of 2022, relating to Morgan County, to further provide for the
5	qualifications and jurisdiction of the judge of probate.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
7	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
8	of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:
9	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
10	Part 1. The Judge of Probate of Morgan County shall be
11	an attorney licensed in this state effective for the term of
12	office of the judge of probate beginning after the
13	ratification of this amendment.
14	Part 2. The Judge of Probate of Morgan County may
15	exercise equity jurisdiction concurrent with that of the
16	circuit court in cases originally filed in the Probate Court
17	of Morgan County if the judge of probate is licensed to
18	practice law in the State of Alabama. In any case subject to
19	this amendment, the judge of probate shall possess the power
20	and authority of a circuit court judge trying the case and the
21	case shall be treated in all respects in the same manner as a
22	case filed in circuit court. The Alabama Rules of Civil
23	Procedure shall apply in the cases except as otherwise
24	specifically provided by law. This amendment is
25	self-executing, but the Legislature may enact additional laws
26	to implement this amendment if needed.
27	Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the

28 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as

29 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional 30 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: 31 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation 32 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise 33 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize 34 35 language; and translate effective dates. 36 END PROPOSED AMENDMENT 37 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285 38 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws 39 of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign 40 a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on 41 42 the election ballot and shall set forth the following 43 description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment: 44

45 "Relating to Morgan County, proposing an amendment to 46 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to require the judge of 47 probate to be an attorney licensed in this state and to 48 authorize the judge of probate to exercise equity jurisdiction 49 concurrent with the circuit court.

Proposed by Act ."

51 This description shall be followed by the following 52 language:

53 "Yes() No()."

54 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as 55 part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by 56 a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
