SYNOPSIS:

This bill would propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Morgan County, to further provide for the qualifications of the judge of probate.

AN ACT

To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Morgan County, to further provide for the qualifications of the judge of probate.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The Judge of Probate of Morgan County shall be an attorney licensed in this state effective for the term of office of the judge of probate beginning after the ratification of this amendment.

Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional

29 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:
30 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation
31 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest
32 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise
33 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize
34 language; and translate effective dates.

END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

36 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
37 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285
38 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws
39 of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign
40 a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on
41 the election ballot and shall set forth the following
42 description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed
43 constitutional amendment:

44 "Relating to Morgan County, proposing an amendment to
45 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to require the judge of
46 probate to be an attorney licensed in this state.

47 Proposed by Act ____."

48 This description shall be followed by the following
49 language:

50 "Yes() No()."

51 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as
52 part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by
53 a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
