5	TO BE ENTITLED
6	AN ACT
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9	Relating to Jefferson County and municipalities located
10	wholly or partially within the county; to authorize the levy
11	of an additional residential building permit fee and to
12	provide for the distribution of that fee.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. (a) The Legislature finds that there is a
15	shortage of skilled tradesmen in the residential construction
16	industry in Jefferson County and the municipalities located
17	wholly or partially within the county. The Legislature further
18	finds that, as authorized under Section 94.01 of the
19	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, the county and municipalities
20	within the county may lend their credit to or grant public
21	funds and things of value to promote the residential
22	construction industry within Jefferson County.
23	(b)(1) The Jefferson County Commission and the
24	governing body of any municipality located wholly or partially
25	within Jefferson County, may levy an additional fee of up to
26	twenty dollars (\$20), for the issuance of a residential
27	building permit. The additional fee shall be set by the

governing body pursuant to a resolution or ordinance and shall

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- 29 be in addition to any other amount authorized by law. A
- 30 municipality shall levy the fee for a residential building
- 31 permit within its corporate limits.
- 32 (2) For the purposes of this section, the term
- 33 residential building permit includes, but is not limited to,
- 34 building permits, mechanical permits, plumbing permits,
- 35 electrical permits, or any combination of the foregoing, and
- 36 any other permit required for the construction or remodeling
- of a new or existing residence or structure as defined in
- 38 Section 34-14A-2, Code of Alabama 1975.
- 39 (c) All amounts levied and collected under this section
- 40 shall be deposited into the treasury of the respective levying
- 41 governing body and shall be distributed by that governing body
- 42 to the Central Alabama Homebuilding Academy, subject to
- 43 subsection (d), which shall use the funds to train individuals
- 44 in skilled trades relating to the residential construction
- industry including, but not limited to, the following:
- 46 (1) Home building.
- 47 (2) Framing.
- 48 (3) Carpentry.
- 49 (4) Electrical.
- 50 (5) Plumbing.
- 51 (6) Masonry.
- 52 (7) Residential painting.
- 53 (8) Sheet rock installation and repair.
- 54 (9) Landscaping.
- 55 (10) HVAC.
- 56 (11) Pipe fitting.



- 57 (12) Natural Gas.
- 58 (13) Roofing.

- 59 (14) Irrigation.
- (d) (1) The Central Alabama Homebuilding Academy shall submit, no later than October 1 of each year, an annual proposed operating budget to the Jefferson County Commission for review and approval by the Jefferson County Commission no later than December 1 of each year. The annual budget shall include a breakdown of all anticipated operational costs and projected workforce programs to be provided.
  - (2) After approval of the academy's annual budget by the county commission, the county commission and the governing body of each participating municipality shall distribute the funds collected pursuant to this section to the Central Alabama Homebuilding Academy. Distributions during the applicable annual approved budget year shall be no longer than quarterly, as determined by the governing body.
  - (3) The Central Alabama Homebuilding Academy shall notify each participating governing body when the academy has received an amount of funding equal to the annual approved budget for that year. Notwithstanding subdivision (2), upon receiving notification, each participating governing body shall continue collecting the levied fee pursuant to this section and shall cease distributing funds to the academy for that year's budget. Funds collected and not distributed to the academy during a budget year shall be retained for supplemental budget distribution or a later year's annual budget distribution as approved by the Jefferson County



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- (e) Funds collected pursuant to this section may not be used to develop or provide continuing education required by any professional licensing board operating within this state.
- (f) (1) No later than June 1 annually, the Central Alabama Homebuilding Academy shall provide to each participating governing body a report on the programs and activities of the academy and a full copy of any annual financial statements prepared by an independent certified public accountant licensed in this state. The conditions of this subdivision shall be satisfied before any governing body may distribute funds collected pursuant to this section to the academy.
- 98 (2) At any time the Jefferson County Commission may 99 subject the academy to an audit.
- 100 (g) Upon termination of the operations of the academy,
  101 any funds collected by the Jefferson County Commission or the
  102 governing body of any municipality pursuant to this section
  103 shall be distributed to the Alabama Construction Trade Academy
  104 Fund in the State Treasury.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1, 2025.
