22	Section 1. (a) In a civil action for damages for
23	personal injury, wrongful death, or property damage, it is an
24	affirmative defense that the action arose from an injury or
25	damage sustained by an individual who willfully obstructed the
26	free, convenient, and normal use of any public street,
27	highway, bridge, or road by doing any of the following:

(1) Impeding, hindering, stifling, or restraining
