11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
12	Section 1. Section 45-50-230, Code of Alabama 1975, is
13	amended to read as follows:

15	(a) (1) In Monroe County, effective immediately, the
16	sheriff is entitled to receive an expense allowance in the
17	amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per annum. The
18	expense allowance shall be in addition to any and all other
19	compensation heretofore provided by law and shall be payable
20	from the county general fund.
21	(2) The expense allowance provided for by this
22	subsection shall be paid each month from the treasury of
23	Monroe County, in the same manner as county employees are
24	paid. The sheriff receiving this expense allowance shall not
25	be required to file an accounting thereof.
26	(3) Effective with the beginning of the next term of
27	office, the sheriff is hereby entitled to receive an
20	additional county calary in the amount of ten thousand dellar

29	(\$10,000) per annum and the provisions of subdivision (1), at
30	that time, shall become null and void. The county compensation
31	shall be paid out of the General Fund of Monroe County in the
32	same manner as other county employees.
33	(4) If there should be enacted a statewide law
34	providing for an increase in the sheriff's salary which, when
35	added to the increase provided for under this subsection shall
36	exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), then the amount of the
37	salary increase provided for under this subsection shall
38	decrease by the amount in excess of ten thousand dollars
39	(\$10,000).
