9	Relating to Talladega County; to establish a service of
10	process fee for the service or attempted service of certain
11	documents by the Talladega County Sheriff's Office in the
12	civil division; to provide for the disposition of service of
13	process fees.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. This act shall only apply to Talladega
16	County.
17	Section 2. (a)(1) The Talladega County Sheriff's Office
18	shall collect a service of process fee of fifty dollars (\$50)
19	for service or attempted service of process by the sheriff for
20	matters pending or to be commenced in a court outside the
21	State of Alabama.
22	(2) The Talladega County Sheriff's Office shall collect
23	a service of process fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) for
24	service or attempted service of process by the sheriff to an
25	inmate at the Federal Correctional Institution in Talladega
26	for matters pending or to be commenced in a court outside of
27	the State of Alabama.
28	(b) The clerk of the court or other designee in

29 Talladega County shall collect the service of process fee 30 designated in subsection (a) and shall remit the fee directly to the sheriff for deposit in the Sheriff's Official Account. 31 32 (c) The Sheriff's Official Account shall be an 33 additional account separate from the budget of the sheriff as provided for in the county general fund. The fees deposited 34 35 into the Sheriff's Official Account shall not diminish, 36 offset, or take the place of budgeted funds or any other 37 source of income established for the sheriff or for the operation of the Talladega County Sheriff's Office. Amounts in 38 39 the Sheriff's Official Account may be expended at the discretion of the sheriff for law enforcement purposes. 40 41 (d) The district attorney, law enforcement, grand 42 juries, Talladega County, and all other counties in the State 43 of Alabama shall be exempt from payment of the fees provided for in this act. 44 45 Section 3. This act shall become effective October 1, 46 2025.
