Section 1. Section 34-28A-21.1 is added to the Code of 27 Alabama 1975, to read as follows: 28

30	Any person not eligible for a license under this
31	chapter who assists in the practice of speech-language
32	pathology or audiology under the supervision of a licensed
33	speech-language pathologist or audiologist, must have the
34	minimum of an associate's degree in communication disorders or
35	related field in speech-language pathology and register with
36	the board.
37	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
38	1, 2025.
