1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to Colbert County; to amend Section 45-17-230,
4 Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for the compensation
5 of the sheriff.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. Section 45-17-230, Code of Alabama 1975, is
8 amended to read as follows:

9 "§45-17-230

10 (a) Commencing with the next term of office, the The
11 Sheriff of Colbert County shall receive total compensation of
12 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) per annum payable from the
13 county general fund in equal installments in the same manner
14 as other county employees are paid. This compensation shall be
15 in lieu of any salary, monthly expense allowance, or fees paid
16 as compensation to the sheriff.

17 (b) Beginning October 1, 2025, the sheriff shall
18 receive an expense allowance to increase the sheriff's total
19 compensation to ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000) per
20 annum payable from the county general fund in equal
21 installments in the same manner as other county employees are
22 paid.

23 (c) Beginning January 18, 2027, the sheriff's total
24 base salary shall be ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000) per
25 annum payable from the county general fund in equal
26 installments in the same manner as other county employees are
27 paid. This salary shall be in lieu of the salary provided in
28 subsection (a), the expense allowance provided in subsection

29 (b), and any other salary, expense allowance, or fees paid to
30 the sheriff which shall be void.

31 (d) (1) Beginning October 1, 2025, the sheriff shall be
32 entitled to all uniform increases in compensation provided to
33 county employees.

34 (2) The amount of any uniform increase granted to the
35 sheriff shall be based on the sheriff's total compensation.

36 (3) Any uniform increase in compensation granted to the
37 sheriff during a term of office shall be paid as an expense
38 allowance until the start of the next term of office.

39 (4) At the beginning of each term of office, any
40 uniform increase in compensation provided to the sheriff
41 during the previous term of office shall be converted to
42 salary, and any converted expense allowance shall be void.

43 (e) Any expense allowance provided pursuant to this
44 section shall be treated as salary for retirement purposes."

45 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
46 1, 2025.
