12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. Section 45-17-230, Code of Alabama 1975, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	" §45-17-230
16	(a) Commencing with the next term of office, the The
17	Sheriff of Colbert County shall receive total compensation of
18	fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) per annum payable from the
19	county general fund in equal installments in the same manner
20	as other county employees are paid. This compensation shall be
21	in lieu of any salary, monthly expense allowance, or fees paid
22	as compensation to the sheriff.
23	(b) Beginning October 1, 2025, the sheriff shall
24	receive an expense allowance to increase the sheriff's total
25	compensation to ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000) per
26	annum payable from the county general fund in equal
27	installments in the same manner as other county employees are
28	paid.

29	(c) Beginning January 18, 2027, the sheriff's total
30	base salary shall be ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000) per
31	annum payable from the county general fund in equal
32	installments in the same manner as other county employees are
33	paid. This salary shall be in lieu of the salary provided in
34	subsection (a), the expense allowance provided in subsection
35	(b), and any other salary, expense allowance, or fees paid to
36	the sheriff which shall be void.
37	(d)(1) Beginning October 1, 2025, the sheriff shall be
38	entitled to all uniform increases in compensation provided to
39	county employees.
40	(2) The amount of any uniform increase granted to the
41	sheriff shall be based on the sheriff's total compensation.
42	(3) Any uniform increase in compensation granted to the
43	sheriff during a term of office shall be paid as an expense
4 4	allowance until the start of the next term of office.
45	(4) At the beginning of each term of office, any
46	uniform increase in compensation provided to the sheriff
47	during the previous term of office shall be converted to
48	salary, and any converted expense allowance shall be void.
49	(e) Any expense allowance provided pursuant to this
50	section shall be treated as salary for retirement purposes."
51	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
52	1, 2025.
