13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. Section 13A-10-12.1 is added to the Code of
15	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:
16	\$13A-10-12.1
17	(a) A person commits the crime of tampering with a
18	legislative record if all of the following occur:
19	(1) The person is requested to publish by a member of
20	the Legislature, in accordance with the requirements of
21	Section 106 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, a legal
22	notice stating the substance of a proposed local law prior to
23	the introduction of the bill.
24	(2) Without the permission of the sponsoring
25	legislator, the person makes an alteration to the notice with
26	the intent to change the description of the proposed local
27	law's scope, purpose, or effect.
28	(3) The notice is advertised with the unauthorized

- 30 (b) A violation of this section is a Class A
- 31 misdemeanor.
- 32 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 33 1, 2025.
