12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. (a) The Sheriff of Clarke County may charge
14	and collect a reasonable fee for services, including, but not
15	limited to, all of the following:
16	(1) Fingerprinting.
17	(2) Reports.
18	(3) Copies of various requested records.
19	(4) Photo identification cards.
20	(5) Funeral duties.
21	(6) Court-ordered ankle monitors.
22	(b) The sheriff may not charge a fee authorized in
23	subsection (a) to any of the following:
24	(1) A law enforcement agency or law enforcement officer
25	requesting a service for law enforcement purposes.
26	(2) An individual applying for a pistol permit.
27	(3) The district attorney or a grand jury requesting a
28	service for a law enforcement, investigatory, or prosecutorial

- 30 (c)(1) The sheriff shall remit the fees collected
- 31 pursuant to this section periodically to the Clarke County
- 32 Commission.
- 33 (2) The county commission shall deposit all monies
- 34 collected pursuant to subdivision (a)(6) in the Sheriff's
- Fund, created pursuant to Section 45-13-232, Code of Alabama
- 36 1975, for law enforcement purposes in the county.
- 37 (d) The proceeds of the fees collected pursuant to this
- 38 section shall not diminish or take the place of any other
- 39 source of income for the county or the sheriff's office.
- Section 2. (a) In addition to all existing charges,
- 41 fees, judgments, and costs of court, the clerk, sheriff, or
- 42 other appropriate court official in the district and circuit
- 43 courts of Clarke County shall assess a service of process fee
- of fifty dollars (\$50) for service or attempted service of
- 45 process on each document requiring personal service of process

- 47 (b) The fee authorized in subsection (a) shall not be
- 48 assessed if a judge finds that payment of the fee will create
- 49 a substantial hardship. A verified statement signed by the

- (c) Each official designated by law to collect fees
- 54 pursuant to subsection (a) shall remit the fees collected to

- 56 (d) The county commission shall deposit one-half of



each fee collected pursuant to this section in the county

general fund and deposit one-half of each fee collected

pursuant to this section in the Sheriff's Fund, created

pursuant to Section 45-13-232, Code of Alabama 1975, for law

enforcement purposes in the county.

- (e) The proceeds of the fees collected pursuant to this section shall not diminish or take the place of any other source of income for the county or the sheriff's office.
- (f) The district attorney and a grand jury shall be exempt from payment of the fees provided for in this section.
- Section 3. This act shall become effective on October 1, 2025.
