9	Relating to Clarke County; to authorize the sheriff to
10	collect reasonable fees for certain services; and to provide
11	for the distribution of the fees.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. (a) The Sheriff of Clarke County may charge
14	and collect a reasonable fee for services, including, but not
15	limited to, all of the following:
16	(1) Fingerprinting.
17	(2) Reports.
18	(3) Copies of various requested records.
19	(4) Photo identification cards.
20	(5) Funeral duties.
21	(6) Court-ordered ankle monitors.
22	(b) The sheriff may not charge a fee authorized in
23	subsection (a) to either of the following:
24	(1) A law enforcement agency or law enforcement officer
25	requesting a service for law enforcement purposes.
26	(2) An individual applying for a pistol permit.
27	(c)(1) The sheriff shall remit the fees collected
28	pursuant to this section periodically to the Clarke County



29 Commission.

30 (2) The county commission shall deposit all monies
31 collected pursuant to subdivision (a)(6) in the Sheriff's
32 Fund, created pursuant to Section 45-13-232, Code of Alabama
33 1975, for law enforcement purposes in the county.

34 (d) The proceeds of the fees collected pursuant to this
35 section shall not diminish or take the place of any other
36 source of income for the county or the sheriff's office.

37 Section 2. (a) In addition to all existing charges, 38 fees, judgments, and costs of court, the clerk, sheriff, or 39 other appropriate court official in the district and circuit 40 courts of Clarke County shall assess a service of process fee 41 of fifty dollars (\$50) for service or attempted service of 42 process on each document requiring personal service of process 43 by the sheriff.

(b) The fee authorized in subsection (a) shall not be assessed if a judge finds that payment of the fee will create a substantial hardship. A verified statement signed by the individual requesting service and approved by the judge attesting the substantial hardship shall be filed with the clerk of the court.

50 (c) Each official designated by law to collect fees 51 pursuant to subsection (a) shall remit the fees collected to 52 the Clarke County Commission.

(d) The county commission shall deposit one-half of each fee collected pursuant to this section in the county general fund and deposit one-half of each fee collected pursuant to this section in the Sheriff's Fund, created

57 pursuant to Section 45-13-232, Code of Alabama 1975, for law 58 enforcement purposes in the county.

(e) The proceeds of the fees collected pursuant to this
section shall not diminish or take the place of any other
source of income for the county or the sheriff's office.
