15	(ALEA); to provide for salary increases for certain law
16	enforcement officers employed by the agency.
17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. (a)(1) Notwithstanding Section 36-26-12,
19	Code of Alabama 1975, the Director of the State Personnel
20	Department shall adjust the pay grade of the pay plan for the
21	following classifications in the state personnel service to
22	the corresponding pay grades listed, effective for the pay
23	period beginning on September 1, 2025:
24	Classification Pay Grade
25	a. ALEA Trooper, Trainee 77
26	b. ALEA trooper 79
27	c ALFA trooper Senior

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d. ALEA Corporal

- (2) The Director of the State Personnel Department shall assign the employees serving in the classifications listed in subdivision (1) on September 1, 2025, to the step in the pay grade equal to the current salary of each employee.
- (b) In addition to the adjustment provided in subsection (a), the Director of the State Personnel Department shall increase the step in the pay grade of all employees serving in the classifications provided in (d), (f), and (g) of subdivision (a)(1) on the effective date of this section by one step, effective for the pay period beginning on September 1, 2025.
- (c) This section shall not prohibit the increase in pay grade for any classification listed in subdivision (a)(1), above the pay grade provided in that subdivision.
- 55 (d) The provisions of this section shall not affect 56 annual merit raise considerations.



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57	(e)(1) The Director of the State Personnel Department
58	shall revise the classifications, grades, schedule of rates,
59	and ranges set forth in subsection (a) to reflect the
60	increases.
61	(2) The Director of the State Personnel Department
62	shall send the revised classifications, grades, schedule of
63	rates, and ranges to the Comptroller who shall issue warrants
64	in accordance therewith.
65	Section 2. This act shall become effective June 1,
