28	(a) For purposes of this amendment, the "Belforest

- 29 Landmark District" in Baldwin County is defined as follows:
- 30 All of Sections 11, 14, 23, 24, 25, and 36, Township 5
- 31 South, Range 2 East, and Sections 19 and 30, Township 5 South,
- 32 Range 3 East of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 33 LESS AND EXCEPT any portion of the above described
- 34 property that lies within the corporate limits of the City of
- 35 Daphne, Alabama.
- 36 (b) No property within the Belforest Landmark District
- 37 may be annexed into any municipality by local law.
- 38 (c) Subsection (b) shall not apply to any municipality
- incorporated after the ratification of this amendment which
- 40 includes any part of the Belforest Landmark District.
- 41 (d) The Belforest Landmark District shall not be
- 42 considered a legal entity and shall not have any of the
- 43 following powers or authority:
- 44 (1) Standing to sue or be sued.
- 45 (2) Taxing authority.
- 46 (3) Zoning authority.
- 47 (4) Police power and public safety authority.
- 48 (5) Authority to adopt ordinances, rules, or

- 52 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the

- Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
- 63 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285
- of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws
- of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign
- a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on
- the election ballot and shall set forth the following
- description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed
