3 Relating to consumer protection; to amend Section
4 8-31-3, Code of Alabama 1975; to further provide for the
5 prohibition of unconscionable prices during a declared
6 emergency.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Section 8-31-3, Code of Alabama 1975, is
9 amended to read as follows:

10 "§8-31-3

11 It is unlawful and a violation of Section 8-19-5~~7~~ for
12 any person or entity to impose unconscionable prices for the
13 sale or rental of any commodity~~or~~, the rental of any
14 facility, or the provision of any service during the period of
15 a declared state of emergency for any time periods and in any
16 affected areas specified in a proclamation by the Governor or
17 a joint resolution of the Legislature issued pursuant to
18 Section 31-9-8(a)."

19 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
20 1, 2025.
