1 2 3 4 SYNOPSIS: 5 Under existing law, a person must possess a license to fish in any public fresh or saltwaters in 6 7 this state. This bill would exempt fishing in waters in 8 9 which a jubilee is occurring from this licensure requirement. 10 11 12 13 A BILL 14 TO BE ENTITLED 15 AN ACT 16 17 Relating to fishing licenses; to exempt fishing in 18 waters in which a jubilee is occurring. 19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 20 Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the 21 term "jubilee" means a natural occurrence in Mobile Bay when a 22 mass of water with a low dissolved oxygen level moves towards 23 the shore thereby forcing fish and shellfish that are 24 attempting to respire between the low-oxygen water and shore. 25 (b) Notwithstanding Chapter 11 of Title 9, Code of 26 Alabama 1975, a person shall not be required to posses a fishing license to fish in or otherwise take fish and 27 28 shellfish from waters in which a jubilee is occurring.

(c) This section shall not be construed to exempt
fishing or the taking of fish or shellfish from waters in
which a jubilee is occurring from regulations regarding the
number and size of fish and shellfish which may be taken.
Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
1, 2025.
