15	Relating to K-12 education; to prohibit a public or
16	nonpublic school from refusing to transfer the student records
17	of a transferring student based on an unpaid balance due the
18	school.
19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. No public or nonpublic K-12 school,
21	including a private, church, parochial, or religious school,
22	may refuse to transfer the records of a student who is
23	transferring to another public or nonpublic school based
24	solely on the student having an unpaid balance due the
25	transferring school.
26	Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
27	2025.
