26 Section 1. (a) Any provision of Section 34-2-32, Code of Alabama 1975, to the contrary notwithstanding, no 27 municipality may require the approval by a registered 28

30	construction of a single family residence that is under three

32	(b) This section shall not apply to Baldwin County.
33	Section 2. Any provision of Section 34-2-32, Code of
34	Alabama 1975, to the contrary notwithstanding, no county may
35	require the approval by a registered architect or professional
36	engineer on plans for the construction of a single family
37	residence that is under three stories in height.
38	Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately.
