9	Relating to Pike County; to amend Act 95-414, 1995
10	Regular Session (Acts 1995, p. 903), now appearing as Section
11	45-55-231, Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for pistol
12	permit fees.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. Act 95-414, 1995 Regular Session (Acts 1995,
15	p. 903), now appearing as Section 45-55-231, Code of Alabama
16	1975, is amended to read as follows:
17	"§45-55-231
18	(a) In Pike County, the fee for issuance of a permit to
19	carry a pistol in a vehicle or concealed on or about the
20	person as provided in Section 13A-11-75, shall be twenty
21	dollars (\$20) <del>per year</del> for one year and one hundred dollars
22	(\$100) for five years, which shall be collected by the
23	sheriff.
24	(b) <del>Ten dollars (\$10) of each <u>Each</u>fee</del> collected under
25	this section shall <del>be paid to the county treasury and the</del>
26	<del>remaining ten dollars (\$10) of each fee shall</del> be deposited by
27	the Sheriff of Pike County, or agents of the sheriff, in any
28	bank located in Pike County into a fund known as the sheriff's



29 **fund**Sheriff's Fund.

30 (c) The sheriff's fund Sheriff's Fund provided for by 31 this section shall be drawn upon by the Sheriff of Pike County 32 or appointed agent and shall be used exclusively for law 33 enforcement purposes and in the discharge of the sheriff's 34 office as the sheriff sees fit.

35 (d) The establishment of the <u>sheriff's fundSheriff's</u>
36 <u>Fund</u>, as provided in this section, and the use of funds shall
37 not diminish or take the place of any other reimbursement or
38 other source of income established for the sheriff or the
39 operation of the office of the sheriff.

40 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October41 1, 2025.
