27 Section 1. (a) The Commissioner of the Alabama

- United States Department of Agriculture to exclude soda from
 the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. If the waiver
 is granted, the commissioner shall prohibit enrollees in the
 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program from purchasing soda
 using program benefits. If the waiver is not granted, the
 commissioner shall request a waiver annually until the waiver
 is granted.
 - (b) For the purposes of this section, the term "soda" means a carbonated beverage that contains more than one gram of added sugar or any artificial sweetener.
