4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, when asked by a law
6	enforcement officer a person has a duty to inform the
7	officer whether he or she is in possession of a
8	concealed pistol or firearm. There is no penalty
9	associated with a violation of this law.
10	This bill would provide a criminal penalty for a
11	violation.

16	AN ACT

18	Relating to firearms; to amend Section 13A-11-95 of the
19	Code of Alabama 1975; to establish a criminal penalty for
20	failure to inform a law enforcement officer of one's
21	possession of a concealed pistol or firearm under certain
22	circumstances.
23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. Section 13A-11-95 of the Code of Alabama
25	1975, is amended to read as follows:
26	"\$13A-11-95
27	(a) Any person who knowingly possesses a pistol or
28	firearm concealed on or about his or her person or in a

29	vehicle occupied by the person, and who is asked by a law
30	enforcement officer operating in the line or scope of his or
31	her official duties whether he or she is armed with a
32	concealed pistol or firearm, shall immediately inform the law
33	enforcement officer that the person is in possession of a
34	pistol or firearm.
35	(b) A violation of subsection (a) is a Class A
36	misdemeanor."
37	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
38	1, 2025.
