32	conviction, shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars

3 4	(b)(1) No person may transport out of this state a live
35	fish of the family Ictaluridae that is harvested from public
36	waters as defined in Section 9-11-80.
37	(2) A person who violates subdivision (1) is guilty of
38	a Class B misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than two
39	thousand dollars (\$2,000) per violation."
