10	Section 40-9-31.1, Code of Alabama 1975, to exempt the Alabama
11	School of Healthcare Sciences Foundation from the payment of
12	all state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. Section 40-9-31.1 of the Code of Alabama
16	1975, is amended to read as follows:
17	"\$40-9-31.1
18	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning
19	January 1, 2021, the Alabama School of Fine Arts Foundation,
20	Incorporated, the Alabama High School of Mathematics and
21	Science Foundation, and the Alabama School of Cyber Technology
22	and Engineering Foundation, and the Alabama School of
23	Healthcare Sciences Foundation are exempted from paying any
24	state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes."
25	Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
26	2025.
