12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. Section 45-51-84, Code of Alabama 1975, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	" §45-51-84
16	(a) The per annum compensation shall be eighty-eight
17	thousand dollars (\$88,000) for the judge of probate effective
18	October 1, 1996.
19	(b) The compensation amount in subsection (a) shall be
20	paid out of the general fund of the Montgomery County
21	Commission in the same manner as other county employees are
22	paid.
23	(c) Subsequent to October 1, 1996, the compensation
24	amount in subsection (a) shall be increased by the same
25	percentage as the across-the-board percentage increase
26	received by full-time county employees at the same time as the
27	increase is received by the county employees, except that the
28	amount shall not be increased by more than three thousand

29	dollars (\$3,000) in any fiscal year.
30	(d) Any individual who has served at least six full
31	years as the Montgomery County Judge of Probate shall receive
32	as his or her total compensation a salary in an amount equal
33	to the salary of a circuit judge with the same years of
3 4	service as the judge of probate. This compensation shall be in
35	lieu of any other compensation provided by law to the
3 6	Montgomery County Judge of Probate."
37	Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
38	2025.
