SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, the state may contract with other states pursuant to the Interstate Corrections Compact for the confinement of inmates.

This bill would authorize the Commissioner of the Department of Corrections to enter into contracts with foreign nations to confine Alabama inmates in a penal institution or correctional facility.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the Department of Corrections; to authorize the Commissioner of the Department of Corrections to enter into contracts with foreign nations to confine Alabama inmates in a penal institution or correctional facility in that foreign nation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The Commissioner of the Department of Corrections may enter into contracts with any one or more foreign governments for the confinement of inmates, on behalf of the State of Alabama, in public or private institutions in that foreign nation. Any such contract shall be on terms
