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SYNOPSIS:

This bill would require the Alabama Department of Public Health to incorporate data related to Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia into public awareness and outreach campaigns related to Alzheimer's and use the data as the department coordinates public health service deliveries across the state.

This bill would also require the department to incorporate certain information and tools relating to the detection and treatment of Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia into education programming for health care providers.
