Enrolled, An Act,

Relating to crimes and offenses; to amend Section 13A-6-153, Code of Alabama 1975; to further provide for the crime of human trafficking in the second degree; and to make nonsubstantive, technical revisions to update the existing code language to current style.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 13A-6-153, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§13A-6-153

(a) A person commits the crime of human trafficking in the second degree if:

(1) ~~A person~~ He or she knowingly benefits, financially or by receiving anything of value, from participation in a venture or engagement for the purpose of sexual servitude or labor servitude.

(2) ~~A person~~ He or she knowingly recruits, entices, solicits, induces, harbors, transports, holds, restrains, provides, maintains, subjects, or obtains by any means another person for the purpose of labor servitude or sexual servitude.

(3) He or she knowingly advertises, either online or in print, access to the sexual or labor servitude of another.

~~-(3)-(b)~~ (b) A corporation, or any other legal entity other than an individual, may be prosecuted for human trafficking in the second degree for an act or omission only if an agent of

29 the corporation or entity performs the conduct which is an
30 element of the crime while acting within the scope of his or
31 her office or employment and on behalf of the corporation or
32 entity, and the commission of the crime was either authorized,
33 requested, commanded, performed, or within the scope of the
34 person's employment on behalf of the corporation or entity or
35 constituted a pattern of conduct that an agent of the
36 corporation or entity knew or should have known was occurring.

37 ~~(4)~~ (c) Any person who obstructs, or attempts to
38 obstruct, or in any way interferes with or prevents the
39 enforcement of this section shall be guilty of a Class B
40 felony.

41 ~~(b)~~ (d) Human trafficking in the second degree is a
42 Class B felony."

43 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
44 1, 2025.
