- which title to an individual unit is transferred to the owner of the unit under a condominium or cooperative system.
- 31 (b) If a residential real property that includes an

  34 in effect on that system or a component of that system:
  - (1) Is automatically transferred to the new owner; and
- 36 (2) Continues in effect as if the new owner was the 37 original purchaser of such system or component, as applicable.
  - (c) A warrantor continues to be obligated under the terms of a manufacturer's warranty agreement for a warranty transferred under this section and may not charge a fee for the transfer of the warranty.
- (d) The transfer of a manufacturer's warranty under this section does not extend the remaining term of the warranty.

- 46 (1) A sale of a residential property that includes an 47 HVAC system as a fixture to the property occurs on or after 48 October 1, 2025;
- 49 (2) A manufacturer's warranty is still in effect on the 50 HVAC system or a component of the system; and
- or after October 1, 2025. A warranty agreement entered into or renewed on renewed before October 1, 2025, is governed by the law in effect on the date the agreement was entered into or renewed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
