8	are hereby presented to Coach Ben Harris for his induction
9	into the National High School Sports Hall of Fame as a

11	WHEREAS, the induction ceremony will take place on
12	June 14, 2025, in Canton, Ohio, the birthplace of
13	professional football and home to the Pro Football Hall of
14	Fame; Coach Harris's inclusion in this elite group, which
15	includes legends like Warren Moon, Ray Lewis, and Michael
16	Vick, underscores his extraordinary legacy in the sport; and
17	WHEREAS, a product of Toulminville High School in
18	Mobile, Alabama, and a former quarterback at Alabama State
19	University, Coach Harris's journey from player to coach
20	exemplifies the profound impact one individual can have on
21	the game; his most significant coaching achievement came
22	during his tenure at Blount High School in Prichard,
23	Alabama, where he orchestrated a stunning turnaround of a
24	program that had struggled for years; and
25	WHEREAS, Coach Harris's arrival at Blount in 1988
26	marked the beginning of a new era; in his first season, the
27	Leopards posted a 6-6 record, including the school's

30	football, winning four state championships (1990, 1992,
31	1996, and 1997) and earning eight regional titles; and
32	WHEREAS, under his leadership, Blount compiled a
33	remarkable 100-30 record, with a playoff mark of 30-5; his
34	success helped solidify Blount High School as one of the
35	premier programs in the state, with runner-up finishes in
36	1991 and 1995 rounding out his legacy; and
37	WHEREAS, Ben Harris's coaching career went beyond
38	just wins and losses; it was about building character and
39	empowering young athletes; his influence extended to both
40	his players and the broader community; and
41	WHEREAS, recognized as a leader on and off the field,
42	he was named Mobile County Citizen of the Year in 1996, and
43	was selected Blount High School Teacher of the Year in 1992;
4 4	he also received multiple accolades for his coaching
45	prowess, including being named Coach of the Year by the
46	Alabama Sports Writers Association in 1990 and 1997; his
47	coaching accomplishments were further celebrated when he was
48	named the NFL High School Coach of the Year in 1998; and
49	WHEREAS, following his back-to-back state titles at
50	Blount in 1996 and 1997, Harris transitioned to a coaching
51	role at his alma mater, Alabama State University, where he
52	served as an assistant coach for five years and briefly as
53	interim head coach; he later returned to high school
54	football at Daleville in 2000, before returning to Blount
55	for his final coaching stint from 2003-2008; and
56	WHEREAS, Coach Harris's remarkable career has earned

58	Association (AHSAA) Hall of Fame, the Alabama State
59	Athletics Hall of Fame, the Baldwin County Hall of Fame, as
60	well as the Mobile Sports Hall of Fame, cementing his place
61	in Alabama's football history; now therefore,
