7 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure,
8 Mountain Brook Chief of Police, James A "Jaye" Loggins, is
9 highly commended for his many professional achievements
10 during his 29-year career on the occasion of his retirement;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Chief Loggins began his career with the
13 Mountain Brook Police Department in 1996 after completing
14 the Alabama Advanced Criminal Justice Academy at the
15 Montgomery Police Department; over the course of his career,
16 he has served and supervised in every division throughout
17 the department, which includes patrol, investigations, and
18 administration, and promotion to executive management and
19 oversight of the daily operations of the agency at the ranks
20 of Captain and Deputy Chief; and

21 WHEREAS, Jaye Loggins was named Chief of Police on
22 October 25, 2021; under his leadership, the department
23 implemented a take-home vehicle program; transitioned
24 dispatch services to Shelby County 911; increased the
25 award-winning School Resource Officer team and cultivated a
26 collaborative partnership with the Mountain Brook School
27 System; adopted new, advanced technical investigative
28 capabilities; and invested in positive community relations

29 through programs and events, including the first annual
30 Community Night Out; and the Mountain Brook First Responders
31 Foundation was created during his tenure; and

32 WHEREAS, Chief Loggins has worked to increase his
33 knowledge and skills, having completed the Alabama Public
34 Safety Leadership Academy and the Managers Preparing to
35 Accomplish Change Today program; as a member of the Tactical
36 Operations Unit, he received advanced training at the
37 federal, state, and local levels as a Certified Tactical
38 Operator; and he completed the FBI Law Enforcement Executive
39 Development Seminar; additionally, he completed all
40 requirements to attain the prestigious Certified Law
41 Enforcement Executive designation as recognized by the
42 Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission
43 and the Alabama Association of Chiefs of Police; and

44 WHEREAS, Chief Loggins earned many awards and
45 accolades over the years, some of which include the FBI Law
46 Enforcement Executive Development Academy Trilogy Award,
47 being named Officer of the Year in 1998 and 2006, and the
48 Safest Cities Award for 2024; and

49 WHEREAS, before becoming a police officer, Jaye
50 Loggins attended The University of Alabama at Birmingham and
51 earned a Bachelor of Science in Justice Science in 2001; in
52 2022, he earned a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice from
53 Jacksonville State University; he has steadfastly served and
54 protected the residents of Mountain Brook leaving a lasting
55 legacy of excellence and community involvement; now
