5 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure,  
6 highest commendations are extended to Chief Curtis Rigney  
7 after more than 33 years of service to the City of  
8 Alabaster, Alabama; and

9 WHEREAS, Curtis began his career with the Alabaster  
10 Police Department as a Patrol Officer on April 18, 1991;  
11 from there, he never looked back and quickly climbed the  
12 ranks to the Chief of Police over a storied career; and

13 WHEREAS, Curtis' promotions were numerous and  
14 consistent; in 1996, he was assigned to the Shelby Regional  
15 Drug Task Force; just two years later, he was promoted to  
16 Detective and assigned to the Criminal Investigation  
17 Division (CID); in only seven months, he attained the rank  
18 of Sergeant in CID; then in December 2001, he was promoted  
19 to the rank of Lieutenant in CID and served as the Division  
20 Commander; recognizing his exceptional leadership skills,  
21 the department made him Captain in May of 2003; in 2008, he  
22 was promoted to Deputy Chief of Police and then in August of  
23 2012, he was appointed Chief of Police; and

24 WHEREAS, Chief Rigney has an Associate Degree from  
25 Marion Military Institute in 1984 and a Bachelor of Science  
26 in Criminal Justice from The University of Alabama in 1986;  
27 in 2000, he graduated from the FBI National Academy in  
28 Quantico, Virginia, as well as the DEA Drug Unit Commanders

29 Leadership Academy in 2008; he is also a Certified Law  
30 Enforcement Executive from Jacksonville State University;
