3 RECOGNIZING APRIL 8, 2025, AS SCOUTING AMERICA DAY.

4 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure, this
5 body commends the Scouting America councils that serve
6 Alabama for their leadership and dedication to preparing
7 young people for adulthood and responsible citizenship:
8 Alabama-Florida Council, Black Warrior Council,
9 Chattahoochee Council, Greater Alabama Council, Mobile Area
10 Council, and Tukabatchee Council; and

11 WHEREAS, membership in Cub Scouting, Scouts BSA,
12 Venturing, and Career Exploring is growing across Alabama,
13 now representative of 15,803 Scouts; and

14 WHEREAS, in 2024, 352 young men and women achieved
15 the rank of Eagle Scout from all of the Alabama-based Scouts
16 BSA Troops; these youth represent Scouting's best and will
