3 CELEBRATING NOVEMBER 5-11 AS VETERANS WEEK IN THE STATE OF
4 ALABAMA.

6 WHEREAS, the United States began the tradition of
7 formally recognizing and honoring its Veterans in 1938 in
8 the form of "Armistice Day" on November 11, the anniversary
9 of the armistice signing concluding World War I, and was
10 "dedicated to the cause of world peace and to be hereafter
11 celebrated"; and

12 WHEREAS, in 1954, acknowledging the sacrifices of our
13 Veterans from World War II and the Korean War, Congress
14 amended the act to redesignate the holiday as "Veterans
15 Day"; and

16 WHEREAS, President Dwight Eisenhower called for "all
17 Veterans, their organizations, and the entire citizenry to
18 join hands to ensure proper and widespread observance of
19 this day"; and

20 WHEREAS, Alabama has sent many of its sons and
21 daughters into military service in defense of our great
22 nation; and

23 WHEREAS, a great many Veterans have taken up
24 residence in Alabama and continue their service in a
25 multitude of capacities serving our communities and
26 continuing their significant contributions to our State and
27 our Nation's defense; and

28 WHEREAS, the State of Alabama wishes to express its

30 Veterans who have honorably served in defense of our Nation
31 and for the cause of freedom around the world in times of
32 peace and conflict; now therefore,

33 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
34 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we designate the period of
35 November 5th through Veterans Day, November 11th, each and
36 every year in the State of Alabama, as Veterans Week and
37 call upon all its residents to observe this time with
38 appropriate programs and events celebrating and thanking our
39 Veterans.
