6 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure, 7 joyful felicitations are conveyed to Mrs. Eunie Walldorf 8 Smith on the occasion of her milestone 90th Birthday and 9 this body would take this opportunity to honor her many 10 years of public service in the State of Alabama; and

11 WHEREAS, Eunie Walldorf was born in the midst of the 12 Great Depression on April 25, 1935, in Chattanooga, 13 Tennessee; Fred Astaire was crooning "Cheek to Cheek" over 14 the airwaves and the runaway success at the Academy Awards 15 was It Happened One Night, winning Best Picture, Director, 16 Actor, Actress, and Screenplay; and

17 WHEREAS, Eunie Smith showed two things at an early 18 age: a fierce intelligence and a steadfast faith in Christ; 19 she graduated cum laude from Vanderbilt University with a Bachelor of Arts in Economics and Business and served as 20 21 Vice President of the Women's Student Government 22 Association; upon graduation, she worked as a Group Actuarial Assistant Data Processing Systems Designer and 23 24 Computer Programmer for Provident Life and Accident 25 Insurance Company; she met and married Albert Lee Smith, Jr. who served as a member of the United States House of 26 27 Representatives serving Alabama's 6th District during the 28 97th Congress; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Smith was devoted to her husband until his passing in 1997; together they shared three children, Karen, Albert Lee III, and Meg, and six grandchildren; as a loving and involved mother, her volunteer activities began with her children's schools, the Junior League and other service organizations, her church, and the Freedom Education Foundation; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Smith has continuously served others in 36 37 the areas of community service, church service, and politics since the 1970s; some of her past service includes, Service 38 Guild of Birmingham; Discovery Clubs of Alabama; Women's 39 Committee of 100 for Birmingham; many roles with the 40 41 Southern Baptist Convention spanning decades; the Governor's 42 Commission on Education Spending; Alabama Governor's 43 Conference on Library Services; Delegate to the 1976 Republican National Convention; and 44

45 WHEREAS, Mrs. Smith continues to serve as a member of 46 the Southern Seminary Foundation Board; a member of the Resolutions Committee for the Alabama Baptist Convention; as 47 the longest serving President of Eagle Forum of Alabama; and 48 49 as the National Vice President of Eagle Forum; she has 50 earned several awards and acknowledgments for her generous gifts of her time and talents, including Congress of Freedom 51 52 Award; Alabama Eagle Award, 1992; National Eagle Award, 1981 53 and 1974; Hoffman Center Award, 1992; and Physicians' Resource Council Service to the Family Award, 1996; and 54 55 WHEREAS, a 90th Birthday is a significant milestone that represents almost a century of wisdom earned and 56
