20	manufacturing of water heaters, boilers, and tanks; in 1937,
21	Rheem expanded internationally, opening a manufacturing
22	facility in Australia to produce shipping containers and
23	household appliances; and
24	WHEREAS, sensing a growing demand for central heating
25	and cooling systems, the company began developing its first
26	heating, ventilation, and air-conditioning systems in the

30	Alabama, to produce water heaters; since its opening in
31	April 1972, the plant has completed two major expansions,
32	manufacturing both residential and commercial water heating
33	systems; and
34	WHEREAS, the Rheem Montgomery Plant has proudly
35	provided continuous, uninterrupted business and job growth
36	in Montgomery for the last 54 years; when the plant opened,
37	Rheem employed 200 people; today, the Rheem family has grown
38	to more than quadruple that number with over 900 team
39	members; and
40	WHEREAS, over the years, Rheem and its employees have
41	proudly supported many nonprofit organizations that serve
42	the greater Montgomery Community, including Habitat for
43	Humanity, Toys for Tots, The United Way, Prattville YMCA,
