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4	HJR CREATING THE STUDY COMMISSION ON THE SALE OF NAMING
5	RIGHTS TO STATE-OWNED LAND, PROPERTIES, AND BUILDINGS.
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7	WHEREAS, the naming rights to state-owned land,
8	properties, and buildings may be sold to private entities,
9	allowing the private entity to have its name associated with
10	the property; and
11	WHEREAS, the sale of naming rights to state-owned
12	land, properties, and buildings offers a unique means for
13	the state to generate revenue; and
14	WHEREAS, this body finds a compelling interest in
15	evaluating the potential profit and effects of the sale of
16	naming rights to certain state-owned real property; now
17	therefore,
18	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
19	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That there is created the Study
20	Commission on the Sale of Naming Rights of State-Owned Land
21	Properties, and Buildings to study and make recommendations
22	regarding the potential economic impact and fiscal
23	responsibility of the sale of naming rights, the management
24	of potential revenue, and the potential environmental
25	impact.
26	(a) The membership of the study commission shall
27	consist of all of the following:

(1) One member appointed by the Governor.

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29 (2	2)	One	member	appointed	bу	the	Lieutenant	Governor.
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- 30 (3) One member of the Senate, appointed by the
  31 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and one member of the
- 32 Senate, appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate.
- 33 (4) One member of the House of Representatives,
- 34 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
- 35 and one member of the House of Representatives, appointed by
- 36 the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
- 37 (5) The Chairs of the House of Representatives Ways
- 38 and Means General Fund and Senate Finance and Taxation
- 39 General Fund Committees.
- 40 (6) A representative of the Alabama Department of
- 41 Conservation and Natural Resources, appointed by the
- 42 Commissioner, or his or her designee.
- 43 (7) The Comptroller for the State of Alabama, or his
- 44 or her designee.
- 45 (8) A corporate attorney with experience in
- 46 negotiating the sale of naming rights, appointed by the
- 47 Alabama Lawyers Association.
- 48 (9) An expert in the field of marketing, appointed by
- 49 the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs.
- 50 (b) Additional members may be added by majority vote
- of the study commission membership.
- 52 (c) The appointing authorities shall coordinate their
- 53 appointments to assure the study commission membership is
- inclusive and reflects the racial, gender, geographic,
- urban, rural, and economic diversity of the state.

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56 (d) The Lieutenant Governor shall serve as the chair 57 of the study commission. The first meeting of the study commission shall be held at the call of the chair no later 58 59 than 30 days after this resolution's passage. The study 60 commission may then meet as necessary to conduct business.

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- (e) The Legislative Services Agency, the Clerk of the House of Representatives, and the Secretary of the Senate shall provide administrative and other assistance for the work of the study commission as necessary.
- (f)(1) The legislative members of the study commission shall be entitled to their legislative compensation, per diem, and travel expenses for each day they attend a meeting of the study commission in accordance with Section 49 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022.
- (2) The nonlegislative members of the study commission shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in attending meetings of the study commission pursuant to the policies of 74 their respective appointing authorities.
  - (g) The study commission shall prepare and submit a report of its recommendations for proposed legislation to the Legislature not later than the fifth legislative day of the 2026 Regular Session, at which point the study commission shall stand dissolved and discharged of any future duties and liabilities.
- (h) Pursuant to Section 36-14-17.1, Code of Alabama 81 82 1975, the study commission shall provide a notice of all meetings, the name of each member serving on the study 83



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84	commission, and a copy of	its final report	and any other
85	documents produced by the	study commission	throughout its
86	duration to the Secretary	of State.
