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7	WHEREAS, the dangers of social media are creating a
8	public health crisis; and
9	WHEREAS, social media, apps, online platforms, and
10	technology are a ubiquitous and worrying part of 21st

22	(a) The membership of the study commission shall

- 46 (b) The appointing authorities shall coordinate their 47 appointments to ensure that the study commission membership 48 is inclusive and reflects the racial, gender, geographic, 49 urban, rural, and economic diversity of the state.
- (c) The appointee of the Speaker of the House of
 Representatives shall call the first meeting of the study
 commission, at which meeting the members shall elect a chair
 and a vice chair from among the membership. The study
 commission may then meet as necessary to conduct business.
- 55 (d)(1) The legislative members of the study 56 commission shall be entitled to their legislative

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compensation, per diem, and travel expenses for each day they attend a meeting of the study commission pursuant to Section 49 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022.

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- (2) The nonlegislative members of the study commission shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses in attending meetings of the study commission pursuant to the policies of their respective appointing authorities.
- (e) The Legislative Services Agency, the Clerk of the House of Representatives, and the Secretary of the Senate shall provide administrative and other assistance for the work of the study commission as necessary.
- (f) The study commission shall study and investigate all related issues and shall draft recommendations for proposed legislation to protect minors from online and technological threats.
- (g) Not later than the tenth legislative day of the
 2026 Regular Session, the study commission shall present its
 findings to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and
 the Speaker Pro Tempore of the Senate. The study commission
 shall stand dissolved and discharged of any future duties
 and liabilities upon presenting its findings.
- (h) Pursuant to Section 36-14-17.1, Code of Alabama
 1975, the study commission shall provide a notice of all
 meetings, the name of each member serving on the study
 commission, and a copy of the its findings and any other
 documents produced by the study commission throughout its
 duration to the Secretary of State.
