7 WHEREAS, the State of Alabama has a rich, artistic
8 heritage that has contributed to its cultural, historical,
9 and educational identity; and

10 WHEREAS, the Alabama Arts Hall of Fame was created by 11 the Alabama Center for the Arts to honor and recognize 12 Alabama artists who have achieved preeminence in their 13 fields and made significant contributions to the artistic 14 landscape of the state; and

15 WHEREAS, the Alabama Arts Hall of Fame has recognized 16 outstanding individuals in the arts, inducting the following 17 distinguished Alabama natives and residents: in 2016, Wes 18 Chapman, Tillman Crane, Emmylou Harris, Nall Hollis, Dean 19 Jones, Bruce Larsen, Quiltmakers of Gee's Bend, and Mildred 20 Nungester Wolfe; in 2019, Truman Capote, Nell Carter, 21 Drive-By Truckers, and Henry Panion III; and

22 WHEREAS, the Alabama Center for the Arts (ACA), a 23 collaborative partnership between Calhoun Community College 24 and Athens State University in Decatur, Alabama, provides 25 accessible and high-quality arts education while fostering a 26 private arts college experience; and

WHEREAS, the ACA maintains strong partnerships with
K-12 school systems in the area, including Decatur City

29 Schools, Hartselle City Schools, and Morgan County Schools, 30 thereby expanding arts education opportunities for students; 31 and

32 WHEREAS, the ACA has received investment support from 33 municipal, county, and state entities and has promoted 34 public art displays throughout the city, enriching the 35 community through outdoor artistic engagement; now 36 therefore,

37 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 38 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Alabama Center for the 39 Arts and its Alabama Arts Hall of Fame are highly commended 40 for its outstanding contributions to the preservation, 41 promotion, and advancement of the arts in Alabama.

42 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Alabama Center for 43 the Arts is designated as the official host and site for the 44 Alabama Arts Hall of Fame.
