3 HJR\_\_\_ COMMENDING JULIE FIKE SAINT FOR EXEMPLARY SERVICE TO  
4 THE ALABAMA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

6 WHEREAS, it is with profound gratitude and sadness  
7 that the Alabama House of Representatives and its staff  
8 recognize employee Julie Fike Saint upon her retirement  
9 after nearly 40 years of devoted service to the Legislature  
10 and the people of the Great State of Alabama; and

11 WHEREAS, Julie Saint started her career with the  
12 Alabama House of Representatives as a part-time typist in  
13 the Enrolling and Engrossing Department on Tuesday, February  
14 5, 1985, and was swiftly elevated to full-time employment as  
15 a Data Entry Operator II in the same department on May 17,  
16 1985; and

17 WHEREAS, in the short span of less than three years,  
18 at the age of 23, she was promoted to the position of  
19 supervisor of the Enrolling and Engrossing Department and  
20 has remained in that position ever since; and

21 WHEREAS, her career has spanned the terms of four  
22 House Clerks, six House Speakers, eight Governors of  
23 Alabama, and an astounding 88 legislative sessions; she has  
24 seen thousands of bills cross her desk needing amendments  
25 incorporated and bills prepared for presentment to the  
26 Governor; she was a critical contributor to the very first  
27 legislative computer system implemented by the Alabama
