6 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure,
7 highest commendations are conveyed to Representative Randall
8 Shedd for his constant and unwavering service to the State
9 of Alabama; and

10 WHEREAS, Randall Shedd started his journey at Wallace
11 State Community College; following his graduation, he served
12 as the Director of the Cullman County Commission on Aging;
13 from 1977 to 1985, he diligently led the Cullman County
14 Commission as its Chair; after his terms as chair and as a
15 testament to his leadership abilities, he was elected Mayor
16 of his hometown of Fairview in 1996 and served four terms
17 until 2012; and

18 WHEREAS, in late 2012, the District 11 seat,
19 representing Blount and Cullman Counties, in the Alabama
20 House of Representatives was vacated; having already proven
21 his ability to serve his local community, Randall Shedd was
22 elected to fill the position in a special election;
23 Representative Shedd was sworn in as a member of the Alabama
24 House of Representatives on April 11, 2013, and has
25 dutifully served since; and

26 WHEREAS, Representative Shedd has held many positions
27 while serving in the Legislature; he is a member of the
28 Legislative Council, the Joint Transportation Committee, the

35 Whip in the Alabama House of Representatives and serves as

37 House Transportation, Utilities and Infrastructure
38 Committee; and Cochair of the Alabama Digital Expansion
39 Authority and the Alabama Rural Broadband Oversight
40 Committee; and

41 WHEREAS, never one to be idle, Representative Shedd
42 serves as an officer in the House Rural Caucus and a member
43 of the Sportsmen Caucus and TVA Caucus; in recognition of
44 his character and strong work ethic, his fellow Republican
