8	we recognize Woodie Pugh, a consummate public servant whose
9	dedication to education and public service has positively
10	impacted Clarke County, the State of Alabama, and beyond for
11	over five decades; and
12	WHEREAS, Woodie Pugh is a trailblazer in Clarke
13	County, having served as the county's first Black
14	Superintendent of Education and the first Black individual
15	to be elected to a countywide office in 2008; and
16	WHEREAS, he devoted 30 years of service to Clarke
17	County's school system, initially as an agribusiness
18	education teacher at Clarke County High School from 1979
19	until his retirement in December 2007; and
20	WHEREAS, before running for Superintendent, he
21	expanded his impact in education as Assistant Principal,
22	Athletic Director, and Day Care Coordinator at West
23	Oktibbeha County High School in Maben, Mississippi; and
24	WHEREAS, he served as Superintendent of Education for
25	Clarke County from January 2009 to December 2012 and later
26	provided interim leadership as Superintendent for Wilcox
27	County in 2013 and Conecuh County in 2015; and
28	WHEREAS, his influence extended beyond administrative

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29	roles, as he was a committed mentor and leader in Future
30	Farmers of America and a presenter for the Alabama Global
31	Vision in 1997; and
32	WHEREAS, his excellence in teaching was recognized
33	when he was named Walmart Teacher of the Year in 2000,
34	underscoring his dedication to student success and
35	educational development; and
36	WHEREAS, he has contributed to his community through
37	service on the Clarke Educators Federal Credit Union Board
38	of Directors and the Children's Center of Clarke County,
39	Incorporated, as well as through his role as a Selective
40	Service Board Member; and
41	WHEREAS, he has exemplified strong leadership in
42	civic and fraternal organizations, serving as Masonic Grand
43	District Deputy for Clarke, Monroe, and Wilcox Counties from
44	2007 to 2015, a member of Abraham Consistory 257, Valley of
45	Demopolis, and holding the esteemed positions of Most Wise
46	from 2016 to 2024 and Commander in Chief of Abraham 257 as
47	of December 2024; and
48	WHEREAS, his commitment to service extends to his
49	past roles as Past Worshipful Master, Past Vice President of
50	Men Making a Difference Social and Saving Club, and a
51	devoted member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated;

53	WHEREAS, a proud native of Coffeeville, Alabama, he
54	is the son of the late Mr. Woodie and Mrs. Viola Pugh, and
55	the proud father of two daughters, Stacey and Kim, as well
56	as a cherished grandfather to three grandchildren, Jaison,

58	WHEREAS, he is an accomplished scholar and lifelong
59	learner, having earned degrees from Alabama A&M University
60	in Huntsville and Alabama State University in Montgomery;
