9 Montgomery, Alabama, whose passing on February 28, 2025, has

28 the United States Army from 1968 to 1970, stationed in

30 1971 to 1997, where he was mobilized for Operation Desert  
31 Storm, retiring with the rank of E-8 Master Sergeant as an  
32 instructor for 92A (Unit Supply); and

34 Fraternity, Incorporated, dedicating over 50 years to the  
35 organization, holding numerous leadership roles, including  
36 Chapter President of Alpha Upsilon Lambda, Recording  
37 Secretary, Parliamentarian, and various leadership positions  
38 in the annual Martin Luther King Jr. Breakfast, where he  
39 served as Chair from 2015 to 2020; and

40 WHEREAS, he was a faithful and devoted member of  
41 Hutchinson Missionary Baptist Church for 60 years, serving  
42 as a Deacon and working diligently to uplift his  
43 congregation and community; and
