26	tournament MVP, Isiah Thomas, finished with 17 points and 13

on the All-Tournament Team are Theotis Dudley, who added 16

30	and seven rebounds; Jones' emphatic dunk late in the final
31	quarter brought the large crowd to its feet; and

34	two free throws with seven seconds remaining; he finished
35	with 13 points, nine rebounds, and five assists; and
