10 WHEREAS, Curtis began his career with the Alabaster
11 Police Department as a Patrol Officer on April 18, 1991;
12 from there, he never looked back and quickly climbed the
13 ranks to the Chief of Police over a storied career; and

14 WHEREAS, Curtis' promotions were numerous and
15 consistent; in 1996, he was assigned to the Shelby Regional
16 Drug Task Force; just two years later, he was promoted to
17 Detective and assigned to the Criminal Investigation
18 Division (CID); in only seven months, he attained the rank
19 of Sergeant in CID; then in December 2001, he was promoted
20 to the rank of Lieutenant in CID and served as the Division
21 Commander; recognizing his exceptional leadership skills,
22 the department made him Captain in May of 2003; in 2008, he
23 was promoted to Deputy Chief of Police and then in August of
24 2012, he was appointed Chief of Police; and

25 WHEREAS, Chief Rigney has an Associate Degree from
26 Marion Military Institute in 1984 and a Bachelor of Science
27 in Criminal Justice from The University of Alabama in 1986;
28 in 2000, he graduated from the FBI National Academy in
