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7 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure, Gail 8 Chaffin Kelley is highly congratulated and commended for her 9 many professional achievements in the field of education and 10 for her notable contributions to her community on the 11 occasion of her retirement; she holds the record in Etowah 12 County for the most years of service in education with 54 13 total years; and

14 WHEREAS, Mrs. Kelley is a 1966 graduate from Gadsden 15 High School; she obtained her Bachelor of Science in 16 Education from Jacksonville State University in 1970, and 17 she later earned a master's degree and her Class AA teaching 18 certificate at The University of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Kelley has had a profound and lasting impact on generations of students; she began her teaching career at Sand Rock High School in 1971; she then moved to Oneonta High School where she taught from 1972-1974; and finally she found her home at Hokes Bluff High School, where she has remained for almost 52 years; and

25 WHEREAS, Mrs. Kelley has a heart for education; 26 throughout her career, she has taught courses in both 27 English and Physical Education; her true passion was for 9th 28 grade English, which she taught for over 40 years; in

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29 addition to high school, Mrs. Kelley also lent her expertise 30 to Gadsden State Community College, where she taught English 31 101 as an adjunct professor; and

32 WHEREAS, Mrs. Kelley has consistently been a fervent 33 advocate for her students, even outside of the classroom; 34 over the course of her 54-year tenure as an educator, she 35 has served as a Student Government Association sponsor and 36 cheerleader sponsor; additionally, she served as the Etowah 37 County Education Association Representative for Hokes Bluff 38 High School for many years; and

39 WHEREAS, gifted with creativity, patience, and a love 40 of literature and writing, she has given generously of her 41 time and efforts to tutor students after school and has 42 often helped underprivileged students secure school supplies 43 and food items; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Kelley has received many awards and accolades over the years, including, but in no way limited to, being voted by her peers as the Hokes Bluff High School Teacher of the Year on more than one occasion and being selected as the Etowah County Teacher of the Year; and

49 WHEREAS, outside of the classroom, Gail and her 50 husband Gerald have raised show horses; she loves animals and has volunteered with and donated to the Humane Society 51 52 for decades, often taking in foster animals; in her 53 retirement, she plans to spend time on her farm with her 54 beloved horses, cats, and dogs; she is also a devoted member 55 of Whorton Bend Baptist Church, where she teaches Sunday School; and 56

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57 WHEREAS, Gail Kelley has lived a life of devotion to God, family, church, and Hokes Bluff High School; her 58 dedication to her students and fellow teachers is an 59 integral part of her notable legacy; she represents 60 61 excellence, intelligence, and an unwavering commitment to teaching; her abilities, vast knowledge, determination, and 62 63 especially her loyalty will be greatly missed by the school 64 that she has dedicated most of her life to serving; and

65 WHEREAS, we wish Gail Kelley immeasurable happiness 66 during her retirement, but undoubtedly her dedication to service and education will not end when she crosses the 67 threshold of her classroom for the last time; rather, the 68 69 commendations within this resolution are given with the 70 knowledge that she will continue mentoring young people and 71 influencing our future generations for many days to come; 72 now therefore,
