7 WHEREAS, Joe Wheeler Patterson, a lifelong resident 8 of the Huntsville-Madison County Community, dedicated 96 9 years to the service of his country, his state, and the 10 citizens of Madison County, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Sheriff Patterson answered the call to serve his nation by enlisting in the United States Army following high school and bravely served in the Korean War; and

14 WHEREAS, in 1958, Sheriff Patterson began his 15 distinguished career in law enforcement with the Huntsville 16 Police Department, rising to the rank of Sergeant over the 17 burglary unit and later served with honor as the 18 administrative assistant to Mayor Joe Davis; and

19 WHEREAS, Sheriff Patterson was a proud graduate of 20 the 77th Session of the FBI National Academy in 1966, a 21 testament to his commitment to professionalism and advanced 22 law enforcement training; and

23 WHEREAS, in 1978, he was elected Sheriff of Madison 24 County and served four consecutive terms, leading with 25 integrity, compassion, and an unwavering dedication to 26 justice; and

27 WHEREAS, Sheriff Patterson's leadership extended28 beyond the county as he was elected President of the Alabama

Sheriffs Association in 1982 and was honored with induction into the Alabama Law Enforcement Hall of Fame in 1994; and WHEREAS, he was a passionate advocate for the Alabama Sheriffs Youth Ranches, where he was instrumental in establishing a Madison County home that provided shelter, support, and hope to countless underprivileged children; and

35 WHEREAS, in addition to his law enforcement service, 36 Sheriff Patterson gave of his time and talents as a board 37 member of the Huntsville-Madison County Airport Authority 38 for eight years, further demonstrating his commitment to the 39 betterment of the region; and

40 WHEREAS, Sheriff Patterson will forever be remembered 41 not only for his decades of distinguished public service, 42 but also for his steadfast character, deep compassion for 43 others, and the countless lives he impacted along the way; 44 now therefore,
